

**1. The HamDam CGHS Ltd.- Membership clearance case of 84 members**

It has been apprised by Sh. M.G. Sathya, Asstt. Registrar that in today's meeting remaining cases of 41 members is placed. The ARCS informed that verification in respect of the said 41 members have also been completed in accordance with the provisions of DCS Act and Rules. Thus 84 memberships have been verified in accordance with the provisions of DCS Act & Rules.



It was further brought to the notice of members of Rule 90 Committee that, pursuant to the directions issued by Hon'ble High Court of Delhi vide orders dt. 03.07.2020, RCS office had conducted the verification exercise in respect of the members of Ham Dam CGHS Ltd. and the cases of 84 members were further placed and considered by Rule 90 Committee in its meeting held on 05.10.2020 and 09.10.2020.

It was further brought to the notice of members of Rule 90 Committee that the Hon'ble High Court vide their orders dt. 01.10.2020 in WP 3409/2020 CM Appl. 12104/2020 has also observed as follows:-

"11. It is clarified that the office of Registrar Cooperative Societies shall restrict to the compliance/verification to the provisions of Registrar of Cooperative Societies, whereas the Delhi Development Authority shall restrict its verification process to the terms and conditions of the lease deed. The applicability of the provisions of RERA shall be considered by this Court at the later stage, if the occasions so arises."

The rule 90 Committee after due consideration of the issued has approved the clearance of the membership of the following 84 members of the society.





The Committee after detailed deliberations was prima-facia of the view that though the provisions of RERA Act are apparently applicable to the society in question, the same was contested by the society before the Hon'ble High Court and its pending consideration of Hon'ble Court as is evident from the order dt. 01.10.2020 referred to herein above. The Committee further observed that since the issue with regard to the applicability of RERA to Cooperative Societies is an important and crucial legal issue which has a bearing not only in the facts of the present case but will also have implications for other cooperative societies in which the construction is ongoing or in which the completion certificate has been received post the notification of the RERA, RCS should immediately approach the Hon'ble High Court by way of an appropriate application seeking requisite clarification in this regard.

It was further decided that pending issuance of further directions by the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi for which RCS would take appropriate steps as above, the details of verification of these 84 members of the society be forwarded to DDA informing DDA that an application as indicated in the previous paragraph is being filed before the Hon'ble High Court.

## 2. Neelanchal CGHS Ltd.


### Membership clearance case of Shri Vijay Kumar Mishra (MS No.119) & Shri Vidyesh Mishra (MS no.199)

The Committee was apprised by Sh. Tanuj Bhanot, ARCS that the freeze strength of the society is 90 and 85 cases have already been cleared earlier from time to time. The cases presently under consideration relates to 02 members i.e. Shri Vijay kumar Mishra holding membership no.119 and Sh. Vidyesh Mishra holding membership no. 199. The society has submitted Schedule VII for clearance of membership in respect of the said 02 members. The Schedule VII proposal submitted by the society was examined in accordance with the provisions of DCS Act and Rules and found in order. The documents submitted in Schedule VII were verified by Shri K.P.Suhag, the then Asstt. Registrar of Section-V and the concerned Dealing Assistant in accordance with the provisions of DCS Act and Rules and the case was recommended for being placed before Rule 90 Committee meeting for consideration. This case was earlier placed before the Rule 90 committee meeting held on 27/12/2019 and 5/10/2020 and due to discrepancy in col. No. 20 of the agenda it was deferred to the next meeting. Today the ARCS informed that the discrepancy has been rectified by incorporating the requisite information in the agenda note i.e. no objections were received with respect to the public advertisement given.

After considering the facts of the case, the Rule 90 Committee agreed to accord its approval for forwarding the names of Shri Vijay kumar Mishra holding membership no.119 and Sh. Vidyesh Mishra holding membership no. 199 to DDA for draw of lots.

### 3. Chinar CGHS Ltd. : Membership clearance case of Ms. Usha Chander (Mem. No. 268)


The committee was apprised by Sh. Gulshan Ahuja, ARCS that the freeze strength of the society is 108 members and 105 members has already been cleared from time to time. The society has submitted Schedule VII for clearance





of membership in respect of Smt. Usha Chander holding membership no.268. Her name was detained on account of being CBI charge sheeted. The proposal in Schedule VII and the documents submitted have been verified by Sh. Jitendra Kumar Singh, the then ARCS & found in order. The said member has submitted an application informing that she has been acquitted in CBI case no. 242/19 vide order dt. 25.09.2020 passed by the Ld. Court of Special Judge CBI. A copy of the judgment has also been enclosed by the said member. This matter was placed in the last meeting of the Rule 90 committee meeting held on 5/10/2020 and was deferred to the next meeting to further examine the matter.


In the meantime, Smt. Usha Chander filed a writ petition no. WP (C) 7601/2020 seeking directions to the RCS to convene a meeting of the Rule 90 Committee constituted under the Delhi Cooperative Societies Rule, 2007 at the earliest so that her name can be recommended to DDA for allotment of a flat in Chinara Co-operative Group Housing Society. It was submitted before the Hon'ble High court that the Rule 90 committee has sought certain clarifications from the RCS and the case of the petitioner has been re-notified for consideration on 9.10.2020. In view of the submission made, the matter has been adjourned to 25.11.2020 for the RCS to convey the decision taken by the Rule 90 Committee.



1. The HamDam CGHS (regn. no. 1284/GH): Membership clearance case of 84 members:

The Committee was apprised by Sh. M.G. Sathya, AR/LO that the freeze strength of the society is 105 members and all are awaiting the clearance. The society has forwarded schedule VII in respect of 103 members. The cases presently under consideration relates to 84 members whose verification was undertaken by this office pursuant to directions dated 3/7/2020 of Hon'ble High court in WP(C) no. 3409/2020. Due to paucity of time, cases of 43 members is placed today before the committee for its consideration & the remaining shall be taken up in the next meeting.

The Rule 90 committee was also briefed that, the Hon'ble high court in WP(c) no. 3409/2020 vide order dated 3/7/2020 has constituted a Committee to monitor completion of all the formalities and for allotment by the draw of lots to the members of the society within a period of 10 weeks. The matter was adjourned to 29th September, 2020.

The ARCS further briefed that verification in respect of 84 members have been completed by Sh. M.G. Sathya, AR and the concerned dealing assistant. In the meantime, 01 of the member Sh. Rajiv Bhatia filed a writ petition no. 6172/2020 in the High court through his lawful attorney in Delhi praying for considering his name for verification as Sh. Rajiv Bhatia who is presently in Australia is unable to come for verification due to covid-19 pandemic. The court vide order dated 9/9/2020 directed to consider the name of the petitioner for purposes of verification of documents subject to the condition that as soon as flights open up from Sydney to Delhi, he shall personally appear before the office of the RCS for purposes of verification. After the draw of lots is conducted, physical possession of the allotted flat shall be handed over to the petitioner subject to completion of requisite formalities.

The Rule 90 Committee was also apprised that since the completion certificate was granted to Ham Dam CGHS Ltd. on 30.10.2018 which is after the date i.e. 01.05.2017 on which the relevant provisions of RERA Act, 2016 came into force; the society was required to submit documents pertaining to registration of its project with RERA Delhi. The society has already been requested for the same vide letter dated 26.06.2020 and 15.07.2020. However, the society has not submitted these documents so far.

After considering the facts of the case, the Rule 90 Committee directed that 41 remaining cases be taken-up in its next meeting along with the directions of Hon'ble High court made in the subsequent hearings.

## **2. Arvind CGHS Ltd.**

**Membership clearance case of Sh. Bhupendra Singh Kalakoti (Membership No. 118)**

The committee was apprised by Sh. M.G. Sathya, Asstt. Registrar that the freeze strength of the society is 114, out of which 112 cases have already been cleared earlier from time to time. The case presently under consideration relates to the membership clearance of Sh. Bhupendra Singh Kalakoti. Sh. Bhupendra Singh Kalakoti was charge sheeted by the CBI and his case is presently pending in the CBI Court. He had filed a WP(C) 9585/2019 titled as Bhupendra Singh Kalakoti Vs. RCS. Vide Court order dt. 30.01.2020, directions were issued that the petitioner's case be placed before the Rule 90 Committee for its consideration. The said member is claiming parity on the basis of judgment dt. 28.03.2016 delivered in the case of Sanjay Bajaj Vs. RCS in WP(C) 2908/2014 wherein the Hon'ble High court has held that merely being charge sheeted cannot be taken to preclude a member from considering his case for clearance of membership. Sh. Bhupendra Singh Kalakoti has been asked to provide present status of the Court case pending against him. The ARCS Housing Section-I has also informed that certain documents are also pending from the society which has been called from them vide this office letter no. 584-585 dt. 17.09.2020.

The Committee after considering the facts of the case has directed that the requisite documents may be called from the member and the society and if need be President/Secretary of the society be requested to attend the office to sort out the issue. Further, RCS Office may also on its own ascertain the present /current status of the pending CBI Case.

## **03. Sri Durga CGHS Ltd: Membership clearance case of 33 members**

The committee was apprised by Sh. M.G. Sathya, AR/LO that the freeze strength of the society is 150, out of which 107 cases have already been cleared earlier from time to time. The case presently under consideration relates to the membership clearance of 33 cases forwarded by the society. Three writ petitions i.e. no. 13167/2019, 13168/2019 and 13170/2019 were filed in the high court regarding convening of Rule 90 Committee meeting. Vide order dated 13.12.2019 the Hon'ble Court directed that in the meanwhile, subject to their satisfying the criteria, Respondent No.1 is directed to forward the names of the Petitioners to Respondent No. 2/DDA.

Another writ petition no. 6277/2020 titled as Neelam Singh & Ors VS RCS has also been filed in the high court and the Hon'ble court vide order dated 10/9/2020 has directed that the Rule 90 committee meeting be convened in the next 03 weeks so that cases of the petitioners herein and other in the wait list can be processed and appropriate recommendations made.



The concerned ARCS informed that while scrutinizing the schedule VII proposal submitted by the society, many discrepancies were observed and in order to bring clarity in the matter, the society has been asked vide this office letter dated 4/9/20 to provide the requisite clarification about the date of arising of all the vacancies, the date of intimation to the RCS office and the date of filling of the vacancies with supporting documents. A proforma (Annexure- A, B & C) was also enclosed with the said letter dated 4/9/20 for providing the requisite information so as to clarify the discrepancies in numbers including resignations/expulsions happened from time to time and resultant vacancies that arose & filling of these vacancies qua the compliance of the provisions of DCS Act & Rules.

The concerned ARCS further briefed that the society through email dated 10/9/20 interalia replied that it has already submitted Form A, B & D along with schedule VII proposal and the information sought in proforma Annexure- A, B & C by the RCS is not provided for under the provisions of DCS Act and Rules. It was further briefed that the reply of the society is not in consonance with the provisions of clause 25 of schedule VII appended to DCS Rules 2007 whereby any other information/documents as may be required under the provisions of the Act & Rules etc. not mentioned in the schedules has to be furnished by the cooperative housing society. The ARCS further briefed the committee about the other discrepancies noted during scrutiny which appears to be serious in nature i.e. details of member enrolled against some membership numbers have not been indicated and intermittent gaps in the membership numbers is also not explained by the society, discrepancies in the membership of some of the members as explained in the agenda, non submission of statutory documents, mis-match in the total enrollments, resignation and expulsion made by the society from time to time etc. The committee was further briefed that due to the discrepancies noted during the scrutiny it is not possible to establish linkages of members enrolled, resigned, and expelled over a period of time by the society.

The committee after due deliberation and consideration of the matter, was of the view that the information already sought by RCS vide letter No. 47/CND/1405/Sec-VII/107301847/284 dated 04.09.2020 needs to be supplied by the society in a time bound manner for proper scrutiny of the matter and the proposal be put up for further consideration of it after proper examination and verification of the information submitted by the society. Clarification also needs to be sought from the society on some other discrepancies noted during scrutiny as mentioned in the agenda so that the directions issued by Hon'ble Court can be complied with. Pursuant to the directions a letter be sent to the society to furnish the requisite information.



After considering the facts of the case, the Rule 90 Committee agreed to defer this case to the next meeting with requisite clarifications.






